PREPARE, AND KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

1. You do not have to answer ANY questions about your status and you may remain silent
2. You have the right to speak with an attorney
3. Do not sign any documents
4. Carry your "A number" (alien registration number) with you; give it to family members, so they can locate you if you're arrested
5. Never carry false documents or identification documents from your home country
6. Carry our business card with you; leave cards with family members to contact us
7. Prepare written authorization for another adult to care for your minor children, if necessary
8. Stay away from raid/detention sites
9. You can apply for protection if you fear harm and persecution in your home country
10. Ask to see a Judge; don't leave voluntarily
11. Ask to see a search warrant for car/home
12. Avoid people who could be arrested: deportation orders, criminal record, etc.
