

MIGRATION ATTORNEYS PREPARE, AND

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

- 1. You do not have to answer ANY questions about your status and you may remain silent
- 2. You have the right to speak with an attorney
- 3. Do not sign any documents
- 4. Carry your "A number" (alien registration number) with you; give it to family members, so
- they can locate you if you're arrested 5. Never carry false documents or identification
- documents from your home country 6. Carry our business card with you; leave
- cards with family members to contact us 7. Prepare written authorization for another
- adult to care for your minor children, if necessary 8. Stay away from raid/detention sites
- 9. You can apply for protection if you fear harm and persecution in your home country
- 10. Ask to see a Judge; don't leave voluntarily
- 11. Ask to see a search warrant for car/home
- 12. Avoid people who could be arrested: deportation orders, criminal record, etc.
